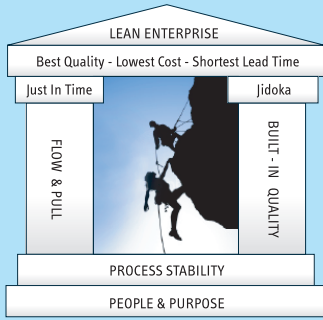


Process Improvement Training
